- Undertaking player injury consultations including of injury assessment, diagnosis and intervention and/or relevant referral as required.
- Reporting of findings and recommendations to the medical and high-performance team as required.
- Advise of health status of player and provide medical clearance for return to play where appropriate.
- Coordinating appointments for medical imaging services, specialist opinions and other medical investigations and deliver reports on outcomes on each case.
- Conducting player medical screenings at the conclusion of each season and the start of pre-season.
- Record and administer all medical substances accordance with AFL anti-doping procedures and remain up to date with ASADA and AFL Doping policy.

As a registered medical practitioner with APHRA you will hold, or be undertaking, post-graduate diploma in sports medicine in addition to having;

- Demonstrated experience in high-performance sport ideally, football highly regarded
- Experience with an athlete management system to record treatment notes
- A sound theoretical and working knowledge of sports medicine.
- Excellent communication skills; consistently, openly and honestly in any situation
- Understands and is able to work in a team environment
